- Computers get
  - Physically dirty
    - Cookie crumbs collect in the keyboard
    - A ball mouse stops working smoothly
    - Monitors get dusty and collect fingerprints
    - Dust bunnies, spider webs, bugs, and pet hair collect inside the computer
  - Digitally dirty
    - Unused programs don't get uninstalled
    - Potentially harmful programs get installed without your knowledge
    - Useless data builds up over time
    - Unnecessary programs get installed

- Tools for physical cleaning
  - Vacuum cleaner
  - Soft cotton cloth
  - Windex or Glass Plus (no ammonia)
  - Canned air
  - Monitor wipe
- Critical instructions
  - Never touch any of the components inside the computer with the vacuum cleaner tool
  - Never spray liquid on any component, spray the cloth
  - Never place your hand inside the computer without grounding yourself first by touching the metal part of the case

- What are we cleaning
  - Use the dust brush to vacuum the keyboard and outside of the computer
  - Use the cloth and glass cleaner to wipe the outside of the computer, keyboard, and mouse
  - Open the computer and use the wand to vacuum the inside of the case (don't touch any components)
  - Use the canned air to blow the dust off of the fans, heat sink, circuit boards, and power supply
    - Suggest you use the vacuum to catch the dust rather than blowing it all over the house
  - If the fan blades didn't come clean, you can use a soft artists brush
  - Put it back together, you're done

- > Tools for digital cleaning
  - Programs and tools that are part of the operating system
  - Programs that you download from the Web
- What are we cleaning
  - Programs that were preinstalled on your computer
  - Programs you no longer use
  - These need to be uninstalled
  - Browser data
    - Temporary Internet files
    - History
    - Cookies

- Email messages
- Disk Cleanup
  - Get rid of everything except
    - Downloaded Program Files
    - > Thumbnails
- Disk Defragmenter
  - Supposed to be doing this on a schedule
  - Check to make sure it is being done
- Antivirus
  - Check the program settings
  - Make sure the data base is being updated when you start your computer
  - Don't exclude anything when you scan the computer for viruses

- Malware detection and removal
  - Use multiple programs
    - Malwarebytes Anti-Malware
    - SuperAntiSpyware
    - Update the program and scan your computer every 10 to 14 days
- > Other programs you might want to use
  - WinPatrol allows you to control what starts when you start your computer
  - CCleaner
    - > Allows you to remove unwanted data
    - Uninstall programs
    - Manage startup programs
    - Clean the registry

- Don't use programs
  - That are designed to update the programs you have installed on the computer
  - That are designed to update files or Dll's (Dynamic Link Library)
